Matthew and Lauren Evangelo are the recipients of the 2012 A.J. Quist Memorial Young Breeder of the Year Award. Matthew grew up on D & E Dairy in Hanford, which consists of 700 Registered Holstein cows and heifers. Matthew raised and showed Registered Holsteins throughout his 4-H and FFA career, Lauren



grew up in Petaluma where she raised and showed Grade Holsteins in both 4-H and FFA. Since they graduated from Cal Poly, the duo has been involved with raising a Registered Holstein herd at D & E Dairy and they purchased their first Holstein together in 2009.

Since then, they have grown their Registered herd to about 25 Holsteins, with many of the animals owned in partnership with fellow Holstein Breeders in California and Wisconsin. Their key partnerships are with Nick and Jessica Sarbacker and Airosa Dairy. In addition to their own herd, Matthew currently works with his parents, Anthony and Teresa Evangelo and brother Jason, to manage and operate D & E Dairy's herd. The Evangelos have also been involved in sale management, helping manage the 2010 Cal Poly Classic, the 2012 Air-osa 100th Anniversary Sale at World Ag Expo, and the 2013 California State Holstein Convention Sale.

Matthew and Lauren have been extremely involved in the Holstein industry, well beyond the farm. In addition to being a lifelong Holstein USA member, Matthew has served on the California Holstein Association board since 2007

holding various roles such as South San Joaquin Holstein Association Representative, Secretary/Treasurer, and being Co-Chairperson of the California State Holstein Show. Both Matthew and Lauren are very involved with South San Joaquin Holstein Association, where Lauren has been Secretary since 2009. Lauren has also served as Co-Convention Chairperson for the 2013 California State Holstein Convention and Co-Chairperson/Founding Member of the 2012 Western Dairy Classic Jr. Show. Additionally, Lauren led the Pre-Convention Tour committee for the 2009 National Holstein Convention.

When asked why they believe Registered Holsteins have a future in their program, they responded, "The Black and White cow has played an important role in both of our lives since childhood and has helped shape us into the individuals we are today.
