Must be a senior in high school or in college to qualify.

Should be in good academic standing in school.

Must be majoring in agriculture.

Use application provided, no additional pages.

## **WORLD WIDE SIRES SCHOLARSHIP- \$500**

Must be a senior in high school.

Must be planning to attend a four-year college and major in an Agriculture field.

**No interview is required for this scholarship.**

Junior Activities with the California Junior Holstein Association:	40 points
Scholarship and Scholastic Activities:	20 points
Awards and Leadership Activities:	20 points
Scope of Dairy Project:	<u>20 points</u>
TOTAL:	100 points

## **DAIRY BOWL SCHOLARSHIP- \$100 each**

**No interview is required for this scholarship.**

Must be a senior in high school to qualify. Only eligible to win this once. Must have participated in Dairy Bowl at the state contest at least three years, including senior year of high school.

## **PREMIER JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIP- \$200**

Students do not apply for this scholarship. Awarded by the judging panel to an individual who has had a positive impact on the California Junior Holstein Association and its members.
